

MINUTES

May 12, 2016

The Somerset Township Board of Supervisors met in Regular Session on Thursday, May 12, 2016, at 6:30 pm in the Somerset Township Municipal Building. Those present were: Daniel H. Halverson, Chairman; Donald Miller, Vice-Chairman and Randy Beistel, Supervisor. Tami L. Yutzy, Secretary and C. Gregory Frantz, Solicitor, also attended the meeting.

Somerset Area High School seniors, Braxton Meehleib and Connor McKinley were also in attendance.

The Chairman, Mr. Halverson, called the meeting to order and lead the pledge to the flag.

Mr. Halverson then asked for any public comment. There was none.

The Chairman asked for the reading of the Minutes of the previous meeting and the Financial Report for the previous month. Mrs. Yutzy presented the board with the Minutes of previous meeting and the April list of expenditures. Mr. Beistel moved to approve all as presented. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. With all voting "yea" the motion carried and all stand approved as presented.

The first item on the agenda was the bid opening for CSS1H Liquid Asphalt. At the instruction of the Chairman, the Secretary opened the bid. The lone bidder for CSS1H Liquid Asphalts was Russell Standard Corp. Mr. Miller made the motion to award the bid for CSS1H to Russell Standard Corp. Mr. Beistel seconded the motion and with all voting "Yea" the motion carried and the Liquid Asphalt bid for CSS1H was awarded.

The final item on the agenda was an update on the 2016 Spring Clean Up. The Secretary provided the Supervisors with a report of this years Clean Up. She stated that during this annual event Advance Disposal Service-Mostoller Landfill graciously accepted 37 truck loads of bulky waste. She also stated that there has been a fair amount of participation since the introduction of the free bulky waste program last Fall. To date 62 free tickets have been issued for Twp. Residents to haul their bulky waste to the landfill free of charge. The Supervisors thanked Advanced Disposal Service-Mostoller Landfill for providing these services to the residents of Somerset Township.

The Supervisors also stated that JVS Environmental Services agreed to handle the recycling of the TVs and Electronic Waste from the clean up. A thank you was issued to JVS as well.

The final part of the Clean Up report was to give recongintion to the Community Work Program of SCI Somerset. The program is under the direction of Jim Fraley and Allan Joseph. The CWP-2 crew pick litter along township roads throughout the summer. Thank you to all the organization listed above for helping to help Somerset Township Clean and Green.

The Chairman then called for any additional business before the Board. There was none. With no other business before the Board, Mr. Halverson declared the meeting adjourned. There were no objections.
