DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

On February 22, 1931 Jesus appeared to Sister Faustina and instructed her to paint an image of Him as she saw Him, with the words "Jesus, I trust in you".

After much persuading and insuring the church authorities that she was not making this up; the image was painted and put on display in her convent chapel. In 1935 Jesus told Sister Faustina "I desire that the image be publicly honored." He instructed her in saying the chaplet. In August 1937 Jesus instructed Sister Faustina to write down and make a novena to the Divine Mercy before the feast of Mercy. It begins on Good Friday. "I desire these nine days you bring to the fount of My Mercy, that they draw therefrom strength and refreshment and whatever graces they need in the



hardships of life and, especially, at the hour of death. On each day you will bring to my heart a different group of souls, and you will immerse them in this ocean of My Mercy, and I will bring all these souls into the house of my Father". This Novena will be very powerful and calming to your life. Praying that you will join us at St. Peter's Church for the following services.
